In recent years, the Foundation offered two different question forms and asked that you answer one of the question forms. Based on the vast majority of prior applicants opting for one form of questions, we are returning to only offering that question form.

The system does not always auto save answers. Please, click on the save button to be sure your content is saved before moving on to a new question.

This letter is intended to be an introduction of your work. We appreciate concise answers that provide clear descriptions of the work you do. We have heard that required character limits add burden to applying organizations. To ease that burden, we have indicated a recommended character limit (in parentheses behind the question) and set the software's restrictions on the answer field's character limit (in italics below the question) to the largest count available. Even though your answers won't be cut off, we ask that you stay as close as possible to the recommended character limit (which includes spaces). The recommended limits may feel low. However, if invited to submit a full application, you will be given additional space to share more detailed answers.

****Please note that the deadline for LOIs is March 30, 2020, at 4:00 pm Central Standard Time. All LOIs submitted after 4:00 p.m. will not be considered.**
